





# DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A STRATEGY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF NIGERIA'S GEMSTONE AND JEWELLERY INDUSTRY PROJECT

### **Announcement of Master Trainer Course**

This **Master Trainer Course** is a part of the project of the Mineral Sector Support for Economic Diversification (MinDiver) of the Ministry of Mines and Steel Development (MMSD). The program is implemented by Projekt-Consult (Hamburg, Germany) in partnership with the Trier University of Applied Science (Idar-Oberstein, Germany) and the Gemological Institute of Nigeria (GIN, Abuja) for the purpose of establishing a high quality teaching and training institution and seeking the development of a skilled workforce through short courses in all aspects of jewelry making.

## **CONTENT**

The training is for a duration 7 months in the following fields of jewelry making:

## 1. Jewelry and Object Design

including visual, technical and material research together with design and making skills:

- a) Foundation basic sketching, illustrations, concept and technical drawings in 2/3D;
- b) Basic metallurgy
- c) Gemology
- d) Creation of innovative jewelry designs styles and traditional jewelry designs
- e) Computer aided designs

## 2. Jewelry Manufacturing

- a) Basic manufacturing skills and exercises (sawing, smithing, alloying, soldering, filing, drilling and basic stone setting)
- b) Advanced techniques (enameling, wax carving, lock and movement making, casting and electroplating surface treatments e.g. engraving and polishing.)
- c) Jewelry Stone Setting:
  - a. Techniques in jewelry stone setting (bezel, collet, prong, flush/gypsy, tube etc.).
- d) Wire jewelry making production of necklaces, earrings, bracelets.
- e) Costume jewelry making, creative design and technical interpretation with emphasis on African traditional designs.







## **COSTS**

All costs of the program including materials, housing and food are covered by the Mineral Sector Support for Economic Diversification (MinDiver) of the Ministry of Mines and Steel Development (MMSD), Abuja.

You are eligible for this Course, if you should have demonstrated experience in either:

- a) Gemstone cutting
- b) Jewelry design/making
- c) Fashion design/making
- d) 3D artistic design
- e) Any other craft or applied art sector
