<b>Application deadlines</b>	International Applicants: December 1st
<b>Fees and costs</b>	Living expenses in Germany approx. 750 EUR per month, tuition fees approx. 250 EUR per Semester
<b>Admission requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A Bachelor's degree or equivalent from an accredited institution,</li> <li>- Existing enrollment in a master's degree program outside Trier University (e.g. in your home country)</li> <li>- Personal Statement from the Applicant will be required</li> <li>- English (B1) language skills recommended</li> </ul>
<b>Visa information</b>	Applicants (Non-EU) must apply for a "Student Visa" at their nearest Embassy or Consulate
<b>Health insurance</b>	Students are required to hold a health insurance that covers their health expenses during their studies both in Germany (insurances can be arranged upon arrival in the country - if you have any questions, the International Office will help you !)
