Opening / Closing Ceremony

These sessions, totalling 9 hours, are free of charge and open to all participants. They will explore the territorial dynamics of tourism in our region, highlighting the role of clusters in fostering local economic development. The lectures will provide both theoretical insights and practical perspectives, led by experts in the field.

Visit of the old town

Day and Night in Cannes

Lérins Island

In an idyllic setting surrounded by unspoilt nature, these two islands facing the Bay of Cannes and the Estérel mountains offer visitors a unique combination of flora and fauna, as well as a singular history blending the mysteries of the Man in the Iron Mask with the tranquillity of the Cistercian monks. More than 100 years after its creation, the Train des Chemins de Fer de Provence continues to transport us through wild nature and authentic villages, from Digne-les-Bains to Nice. From the land of fine lavender to that of chestnut trees, the Train des Pignes has been a strong element of Provençal collective memory for a century. Old-fashioned charm giving way to modernity, the new trains of the train with large windows allow visitors to fully enjoy the landscapes: uninterrupted parade of waterways, mountains and gorges.

Entrevaux

An exceptional medieval city.

Let your imagination take you on a tour of this fortified town, which has retained all the charm of times gone by. Lose yourself in the winding lanes that bear witness to ancient times. Don't forget to climb up to the Citadelle, perched like a knight on his way to the castle, for unbeatable views of the village and valley!



Sport Museum

Devoted to sport in all of its different forms, the Museum is open to all. Its collection of objects bear testimony to sport's finest hours, whisking visitors away on a journey through the museum's 2,000 m² of exhibitions. The National Sports Museum houses one of the most important sports collections in the world. Saint Cézaire Cave

Discover the cave and explore the depths of the earth at over 40 meters.

Take a 200-metre journey through stalagmites, stalactites, columns, Aragonite calcite crystallization... See exceptional concretions over 6 million years old.

The only one of its kind in France, the tour includes a 17-metre-high fluorescent waterfall. One of the most beautiful underground adventures of the French Riviera to do with family or friends!

Visit of Galimard Museum and perfume creation workshop

Maison de Parfums Galimard in Grasse invites you to explore the enchanting world of perfumery through a captivating guided tour. Discover over 275 years of olfactory heritage as you visit our museum, laboratory, and packaging workshops, where tradition meets innovation. Perfume creation workshop

Offers a unique experience for duos to discover the art of perfume creation together. By the end of the workshop, each of you will craft a personalized perfume and take home a 50ml bottle labeled with your chosen name, with your formulas saved for future reorders.
