

Information on the language requirements for admission to the Bachelor's degree programme in International Business at Trier University of Applied Sciences

Applicants for the International Business degree programme must demonstrate high language skills in English.

Proof of language skills in English can be provided by one of the following:

- General Higher Education Entrance Qualification that allows for admission to study at a German university in English.
- TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) (at least 72/120 points internet based)
- Duolingo test with a minimum score of 105 or
- Cambridge Advanced Certificate English (CAE) or Cambridge First Certificate English (FCE) with at least 160 points
- IELTS (International English Language Testing System) at least B2 level (at least 5.5 points)
- TELC (The European Language Certificates) at least B2 level

Proof of language skills in German can be provided by one of the following:

- Goethe Zertifikat A2 (or higher) or
- telc Deutsch A2 (or higher) or
- ÖSD-Zertifikat A2 (or higher) or
- Deutsches Sprachdiplom der Kultusministerkonferenz Stufe I DSD I (or higher) or
- TestDaF TDN 3 (or higher) or
- DSH-1 (or higher) or
- Acquisition of the university entrance qualification in German
