In 2025, the project Graduate International Research Opportunities (GIRO) provides a total of € 12,500 to support PhD students with international publications.

**All PhD students registered or enrolled at Trier University of Applied Sciences are eligible to apply.**  
**The submission deadline is 30 April, 2025.**



## Up to € 2,500 for Publication Costs and € 1.000 for Proofreading

Joint publishing with researchers worldwide expands academic, professional, and personal skills and strengthens the international network of doctoral students.

1. Funding is available for publications in internationally renowned journals as well as for publications that are co-authored internationally with other doctoral students and researchers from foreign partner universities.
2. Successful candidates receive access to a professional (foreign) language editing service to have their publication proofread.

Please use the attached application form. Proposals should include the following:

- Title of doctoral thesis
- Supervising professor at Trier University of Applied Sciences
- Exposé of your publication proposal
- Participating researchers in Germany and abroad
- Publication details (type of publication, publisher, license)

A selection committee consisting of the vice president for research, the project manager, the research and PhD coordinators as well as the project coordinator will decide on the allocation of the funds. The allocated funds must be spent within the calendar year of 2025. If possible, the publication should be completed by October 2025.
