You can also continue exploring Trier or visit some beautiful nearby towns such as **Saarburg** or **Cochem**.



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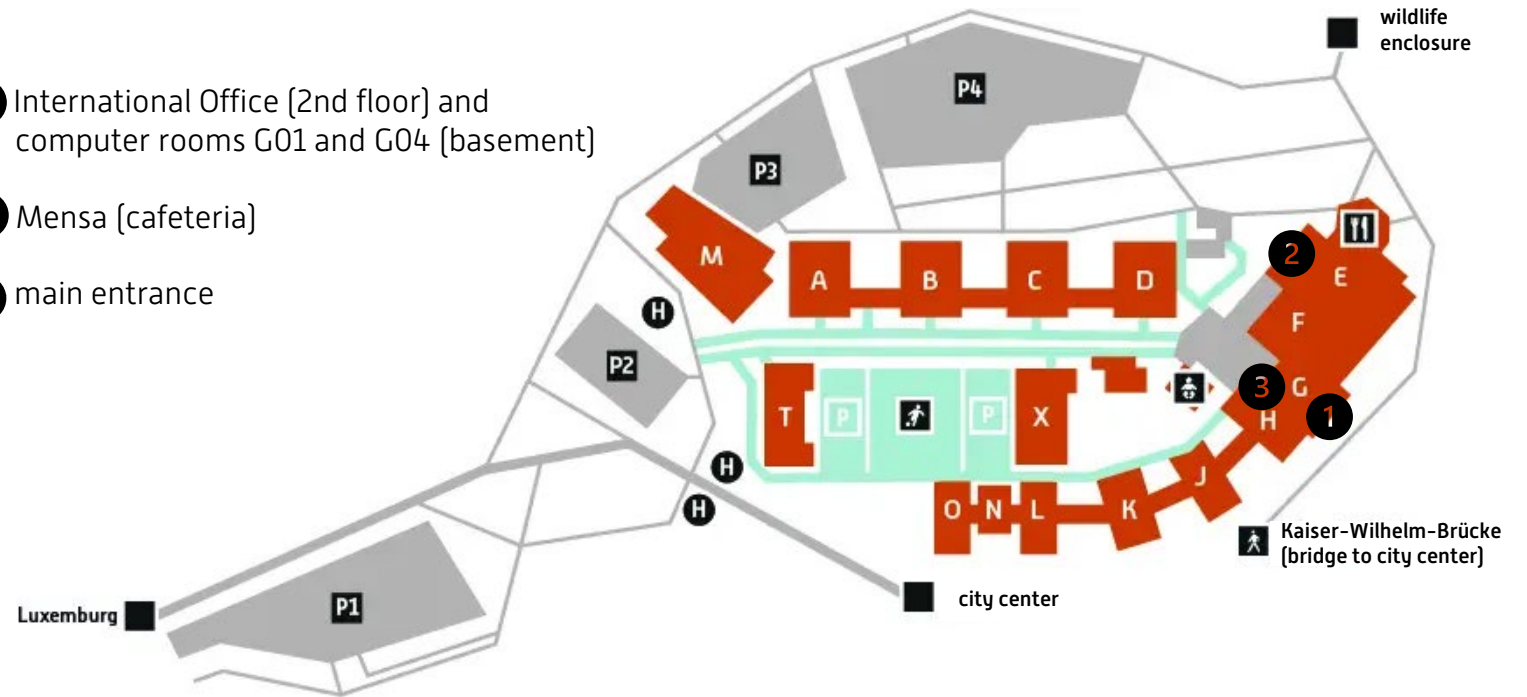
