

Financial support for single parents

The scholarship trust of the Rhineland-Palatine county offers single parent students and single pregnant students – independent of their BAföG-status – support in financially difficult situations. The program aims to stop students from dropping out and to graduate successfully.

Requirements on part of the student:

- The student has to be enrolled at the Trier University of Applied Sciences
- Single parent or pregnant student
- Existence of a financial emergency (No permanent need)

The application form should contain the following information:

- Personal details of the student and child(ren)
- Declaration and proof of expenditure and income for the last 6 months
