## Security on foreign travel (Issue 01/26)

*Foreign travel is part of our everyday professional lives and requires sensitive handling of company data. Information security on your end devices is of utmost importance, especially on business trips. In the following we show you what you should pay attention to and how we can best support you in this matter.*

### **Where are you headed?>>> Support? Yes, gladly!>>>**

In principle, the measures for maintaining information security depend on the respective destination country. Risks such as eavesdropping and espionage of information, violations of local laws, coercion, blackmail, kidnapping as well as corruption or theft and therefore the loss of devices, storage media and documents can arise. Therefore always remain vigilant. Contact the Information Security team if you are unsure which information security measures are important for the respective destination country.

We can provide additional support in the following ways: Procurement of privacy screen filters; Setting up a code lock on the mobile end device; Setting up a VPN connection; Encryption of portable storage media and IT systems (e.g., Bitlocker); Advice on using public Wi-Fi, taking necessary data and documents with you; Setting up a secure remote access, digital signatures, etc.

Please contact us as soon as you are confronted with risks. Also feel free to inform us in advance by email or telephone before you go on foreign trips, so that we can respond to your inquiries faster and more precisely.
