

Scholarship for talented students from the scholarship foundation of the state scholarship program for German and foreign students at Trier University of Applied Sciences - Notes on the application and the evaluation report -

Information for applicants

The application (page 2 of this document) should be completed by the applicants. It should then be sent with all attachments in electronic form as a single pdf document with the reference "Landesstipendium" to the President's Office at landesstipendium@hochschule-trier.de. The attachments include a maximum one-page self-presentation of the applicant, as well as a tabular, maximum one-page curriculum vitae, from which the achievements required in the criteria are clear, as well as copies of certificates, diplomas and other evidence that document the application and the applicant's CV and from which the applicant's talent can be seen. An official, complete grade transcript with grade point average (determined by the examination office) is important!

Notes for the evaluation report

The file Gutachten_zum_Stipendienantrag.doc must be used to prepare the evaluation report.

Application deadline

Applications must be received in full with all attachments in electronic form as one coherent pdf document by the specified deadline via the e-mail address: landesstipendium@hochschule-trier.de. Applications received after the deadline cannot be considered.

Limits of cumulative talent financing

Simultaneous receipt of other talent and performance-related scholarships is not permitted.

Only students of Trier University of Applied Sciences: Applicants must be enrolled students at Trier University of Applied Sciences with a Bachelor's, Master's or Diploma degree.

Selection criteria

1) Academic aptitude

Applicants must have a very high level of academic aptitude. The following characteristics are relevant to the assessment in this context: School-leaving certificate, academic qualification, artistic qualification, exam performance and study achievements, seminar papers, theses, involvement in research, examinations, other academic and artistic activities and experience, internships, academic and artistic awards.

2) General personal suitability

Under the condition that a very high academic aptitude exists, further characteristics are to be assessed: Active interests outside the subject area, experience abroad, age and length of study,

3) Social commitment

Activities are taken into account here, such as participation in student university and self-administration, participation in the care of relatives, participation in aid organizations (e.g. DRK, THW, fire brigade), assumption of responsibility in other organizations or associations or political commitment, awards for voluntary work,

- (4) Copies of certificates, diplomas and other evidence documenting the application and curriculum vitae and showing the applicant's aptitude,
- (5) an official full transcript of records showing the average grade achieved to date (printout from the examination office).
